CERTIFICATE IN FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING (CIFA)

The solid foundation



A very good beginners' course that prepares one for clerical accounting work usually carried out by accounts assistants. This is also a stepping stone to the Accounting Technician programme.

The programme has four papers assessed through three hour written examinations.

Entry requirements

The minimum entry qualication is the Malawi School Certificate of Education(MSCE) or its equivalent.

ACCOUNTING TECHNICIAN/DIPLOMA

Gateway to degree level and a stepping stone to the Chartered Accountant Malawi qualification



This is the most sought after qualification that prepares staff who provide vital support to the work of middle management accounting officers. Holders of this qualification are eligible to register for bachelors degree programes in year 3. Holders are also eligible to register with the Malawi Accountants Board (MAB) as diplomate members after completing the required practical training. The programme has twelve papers which are assessed through thre hour written examinations

Entry requirements

The Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or equivalent with credit passes in English and Mathematics or a CIFA.

THE CHARTEED ACCOUNTANT MALAWI (CA Malawi)

A step into greatness



Those who complete this program end up as finance managers, chief finance officers, finance directors, chief executive officers and others. These are all high rewarding jobs. The CA(M) qualification has three levels as follows:

CA Level 1 (Knowledge)

Consists of 7 'introductory' examination papers all of which are assessed through written examinations. Students are

introduced to concepts and essentials of accounting and business, providing a ground on which further levels would build

CA Level 2 (Professional)

Consists of six 'application' examination papers two of which are assessed through written examinations and four are assessed through computer based examinations (CBE). Students are introduced to deep and wide range of accounting and business issues, functions, principles, regulations, strategies and implications. Critically, the examinations require candidates to demonstrate knowledge through practical application to everyday business situations. Technical skills and work experience include expert advice, professional reasoning and judgment plus excellent communication skills. The papers at this level are as follows:

B3 Audit & Assurance (CBE)

CA Level 3 (Final)

Consists of two 'advanced' papers both of which are assessed through computer based examinations (CBE). The examinations at this level test higher levels of analytical skills. The papers at this level are:
